

Bishop Brothers and sisters, we have come together to worship Almighty God, who has called us into the fellowship of his universal Church through baptism. God has given us the gifts of word and sacrament and entrusted us with his work of healing the broken hearted and setting the captive free.

Over the years God has been working through this releasing ministry, and has now brought us together for this next chapter in the life and ministry of healing and wholeness throughout Canterbury Diocese, and in Nonington at The Living Well. Today we mark this in the licensing of the *third* chaplain to The Living Well: Reverend Lorraine Apps-Huggins.

As we prepare for this new ministry:

We pray for each other in our calling as ministers of Christ's gospel of grace, healing and love:

Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen: to loose the chains of injustice and untie the cords of the yoke, to set the oppressed free and break every yoke? Is it not to share your food with the hungry and to provide the poor wanderer with shelter – when you see the naked, to clothe them, and not to turn away from your own flesh and blood? Then your light will break forth like the dawn, and your healing will quickly appear; then your righteousness will go before you, and the glory of the Lord will be your rear guard. Then you will call, and the Lord will answer; you will cry for help, and he will say: Here am I.

Sermon Bishop Tim

The Licensing

- **Bishop** Lorraine I ask you, in the presence of this congregation, are you willing to undertake the ministry of chaplain at The Living Well?
- Lorraine I am, the Lord being my helper.
- The Church of England is part of the One, Holy **Bishop** Catholic and Apostolic Church worshipping the one true God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. It professes the faith uniquely revealed in the Holy Scriptures and set forth in the Catholic Creeds, which the Church is called upon to proclaim afresh in each generation. Led by the Holy Spirit, it has borne witness to Christian truth in its historic formularies, the Thirty-Nine Articles of Religion, the Book of Common Prayer, and the Ordering of Bishops, Priests and Deacons. In the Declaration you are about to make, will you affirm your loyalty to this inheritance of faith as your inspiration and guidance under God, in bringing the grace and truth of Christ to this generation and making Him known to those in your care?
- Lorraine I, Lorraine Georgina Apps-Huggins, do so affirm, and accordingly declare my belief in the faith which is revealed in the Holy Scriptures and set forth in the Catholic Creeds and to which the historic formularies of the Church of England bear witness; and in public prayer and administration of the

Sacraments, I will use only the Forms of Service which are authorised or allowed by the Canon.

Taking a New Testament, she turns to the people and says; I, Lorraine Georgina Apps-Huggins, swear that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second, her heirs and successors, according to law: so help me God.

Turning to the Bishop, she says;

I, Lorraine Georgina Apps-Huggins, do swear by Almighty God that I will pay due and canonical obedience to the Lord Archbishop of Canterbury and his successors in all things lawful and honest: so help me God.

The Priest signs the Declarations.

- **Bishop** Christian Ministry is a partnership. Lorraine, will you work with your colleagues in this Diocese to build up the Body of Christ?
- Lorraine With God's help I will.
- **Bishop** Friends, trustees and associates of The Living Well will you work joyfully with your new colleague in the spirit of collaboration and discipleship?
- All With the help of God we will.
- Bishop People of God will you uphold Lorraine in your prayers and share with them in this ministry?All We will.

- Bishop Almighty Father, give your servant Lorraine grace to fulfil her calling in this Diocese.
 Give her reverence in ministering the sacraments, faithfulness in proclaiming your word, diligence in pastoral care, tenderness in comforting, power in healing the wounds of Christ's people, and humility and self-sacrifice in all things: that, following the steps of your Son, she may guide your people towards eternal joy; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.
- The Bishop hands the licence to Lorraine, saying; Receive this license, which is both mine and yours; in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
- Bishop The God of peace, who brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, make you perfect in every good work to do his will; and the blessing of God Almighty, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, be upon you and upon all your work done in his name. Amen.

Reading John 10:11-16 read by Rev. Dr. John Huggins

I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. The hired hand is not the shepherd who owns the sheep. So when he sees the wolf coming he abandons the sheep and runs away. Then the wolf attacks the flock and scatters it. The man runs away because he is a hired hand and cares nothing for the sheep. I am the good shepherd; I know my sheep and my sheep know me - just as the father knows me and I know the Father - and I lay down my life for the sheep. I have other sheep that are not of this sheep pen. I must bring them also. They too will listen to my voice, and there shall be one flock and one shepherd. Song

Following this song symbols of the healing ministry of Christ are brought forward.

Steve and Stella bring the Bible and a lit candle saying: 'God's word freshly breathed...' 'God's light we hold it and pray for others...' Annelise brings oil saying: 'oil, the healing and anointing of God upon our lives...' Hilary brings bread, and on behalf of Ron wine, saying: 'bread and wine, heavenly food that sustains our journey...' Lorraine brings water saying: 'water immersing, cleansing, and refreshing us...'

Each person remains standing at the front.
