To be collaborative in ministry with enthusiasm to learn with and work alongside a flexible team.

To be a good communicator and listener with evidence of an ability to lead, teach and train others in this ministry. To be able to use a variety of teaching styles and to use current technology as appropriate.

To have experience of a leadership role in parish ministry.
